Subject: R-39-23: 2023 City of Annapolis Hazard Mitigation Plan

Purpose of legislation

The purpose of this legislation is to adopt the 2023 City of Annapolis Hazard Mitigation Plan, as required by the Federal Emergency Management Agency, to maintain eligibility for disaster funding for large-scale emergencies and disasters and mitigation grant funding.

Impact of legislation on operations

This legislation will allow the City to move forward both with the specific measures identified in the Plan as well as other projects that rely on funding from FEMA. The legislation does not create new projects per se but instead allows existing plans and projects to continue.

Impact of legislation on staffing

This legislation allows existing staffing patterns and plans to continue.
