19 **AN ORDINANCE** concerning

21 **Amending the Composition of the Maritime Advisory Board**

23 **FOR** the purpose of replacing the Chair of the Annapolis Conservancy Board with a
24 representative of the maritime industry to serve on the Maritime Advisory Board.

26 **BY** repealing and re-enacting with amendments the following portions of the Code of
27 the City of Annapolis, 2015 Edition
28 Section 2.48.240

29
30 **WHEREAS,** Pursuant to Section 2.48.240 of the Annapolis City Code, the composition
31 of the Maritime Advisory Board includes the Chair of the Annapolis
32 Conservancy Board; and

33
34 **WHEREAS,** The Chair of the Annapolis Conservancy Board does not regularly attend
35 meetings of the Maritime Advisory Board;

36
37 **WHEREAS,** The Chairs of both Boards have requested that the Chair of the Annapolis
38 Conservancy Board be removed from serving on the Maritime Advisory
39 Board.

41 **NOW THEREFORE**

43 **SECTION I: BE IT ESTABLISHED AND ORDAINED BY THE ANNAPOLIS**
44 **CITY COUNCIL** that the Code of the City of Annapolis shall be amended to read as
45 follows:

1 **CHAPTER 2.48 – BOARDS, COMMISSIONS AND COMMITTEES**
2 **ARTICLE VIII – MARITIME ADVISORY BOARD**

4 **2.48.240 Composition and terms.**

5
6 A. The Maritime Advisory Board consists of eleven members:

7
8 1. ~~Seven~~ EIGHT members representing the maritime industry, three of
9 whom shall employ no more than twenty people;

10
11 ~~2. The chair of the Annapolis Conservancy Board or designee;~~

12
13 ~~3.~~ 2. The Aldermen representing wards 1, 7, and 8 which contain the
14 maritime zoning districts, or such persons employed in the maritime
15 business as said Aldermen may designate in writing to the Mayor to serve
16 in lieu of the Aldermen.

17
18 B. Members of the Maritime Advisory Board shall be appointed by the Mayor,
19 subject to confirmation by the City Council, for terms of four years, except that
20 the respective terms of the members representing the maritime industry shall be
21 on a staggered basis. A vacancy in the membership on the council shall be filled
22 for the remainder of the unexpired term in the same manner as an original
23 appointment.

25 C. In addition to the members of the Maritime Advisory Board as provided for in
26 subsection A of this section, the Mayor, from time to time, may designate City
27 officials and members of other City boards or commissions as the Mayor deems
28 appropriate to participate in the activities of the board in an ex officio, nonvoting
29 capacity.

31 **SECTION II: AND BE IT FURTHER ESTABLISHED AND ORDAINED BY THE**
32 **ANNAPOLIS CITY COUNCIL** that this Ordinance shall take effect from the date of its
33 passage.
