**AN ORDINANCE** concerning

**FOR** the purpose of renaming the Stormwater Utility Fund, which shall be known henceforth as the Watershed Restoration Fund, to more accurately reflect the functionality of the Fund.

**BY** repealing and re-enacting with amendments the following portions of the Code of the City of Annapolis, 2016 Edition  
17.10.180

**SECTION I: BE IT ESTABLISHED AND ORDAINED BY THE ANNAPOLIS CITY COUNCIL** that the Code of the City of Annapolis shall be amended to read as follows:

**TITLE 17 – BUILDINGS AND CONSTRUCTION**

**Chapter 17.10 – STORMWATER MANAGEMENT**

**Section 17.10.180 - ~~Stormwater utility~~ WATERSHED RESTORATION fund.**

A. A ~~stormwater utility~~WATERSHED RESTORATION fund shall be established and the moneys therein shall be used by the City for land acquisition (including easements and rights-of-way), and the study, engineering, design, purchase,

- 1 construction, expansion, repair, maintenance, landscaping and inspection of  
2 public stormwater management systems.
- 3 B. The ~~stormwater utility~~ WATERSHED RESTORATION fee schedule applicable to  
4 the fund shall be established by resolution of the City Council. The feeS schedule  
5 shall reflect an annual two percent rate increase in effect from July 1, 2015 until  
6 June 30, 2018 for stormwater fees under this Section. To encourage  
7 environmentally sound and effective stormwater management practices, the  
8 Director of the Department of Public Works may authorize a reduction in the  
9 ~~stormwater utility~~ WATERSHED RESTORATION fee not to exceed fifty percent  
10 in accordance with a duly established policy setting forth which stormwater  
11 management facilities shall qualify for a reduction of the ~~stormwater~~

- 14 C. In the case of an application for a waiver to on-site water quantity and/or water  
15 quality management under this chapter, the Director of Public Works may in  
16 his/her discretion accept the conveyance of an interest in land, the construction of  
17 a stormwater management facility, the scheduled fee or any equivalent  
18 combination thereof as the ~~stormwater utility~~ WATERSHED RESTORATION

- 20 D. The Director of Public Works shall not accept a conveyance of land or the  
21 construction of a stormwater management facility pursuant to the preceding  
22 Subsection that does not cover adequately the cost to the City of managing the  
23 stormwater generated from the subject property or if such acceptance is otherwise  
24 not in the interest of the City.
- 25 E. Public Works is responsible for maintenance, repair and retrofit of stormwater  
26 facilities that lie in the public right-of-way and these funds shall be used to this  
27 effect.
