This FY 2015 State Homeland Security Grant Program Sub-Recipient Agreement is being generated to reflect funds provided to the City of Annapolis in order to better prevent, deter, respond to, and recover from environmental threats and incidents of terrorism. These grant funds will be used to enhance the capabilities of responders and the Annapolis Emergency Operations Center (EOC).
