Subject: R-27-19: Eastport and Forest Drive Communities and Governmental Agencies Task Force

This resolution establishes the Eastport and Forest Drive Communities and Governmental Agencies Task Force. The purpose of the task force is to provide the Mayor and City Council with a public forum for continuing to study and prepare reports about the Forest Drive/Eastport Sector Study, to allow residents to provide input regarding the 2020 Comprehensive Plan, and to collaborate with the Anne Arundel County and the State of Maryland. The task force shall meet at least quarterly and take public testimony, and the task force will submit quarterly reports to the Mayor and City Council.

The resolution does not state who will determine the membership of the task force, although it does say the task force is limited to 21 members, including the Director of Planning and Zoning or the Director's designee. Membership shall also represent each ward, and the County and State will be asked to provide support staff and assist the task force.
