24 **Water and Sewer Service Agreement - 44 Hudson Street, LLC**

25
26 **FOR** the purpose of authorizing a water and sewer service agreement providing for the
27 extension of City water and sewer services to 44 Hudson Street, LLC located in
28 Anne Arundel County; and matters generally relating to providing said water and
29 sewer service outside the City limits.

30
31 **WHEREAS,** the Property Owner is the fee simple owner of an improved parcel of land
32 consisting of approximately 1.63 acres, more or less, located at 44 Hudson
33 Street, Annapolis, Maryland 21401 and as more accurately described in a
34 deed recorded at Liber 06463, folio 525 among the Land Records of Anne
35 Arundel County (collectively, the “Property”), and with mailing addresses
36 of 45 and 49 Hudson Street; and

37
38 **WHEREAS,** the Property is presently located outside the City limits of the City of
39 Annapolis, and is presently under development pursuant to grading and
40 building permits issued by Anne Arundel County for the construction of
41 two (2) buildings intended for occupancy by commercial tenants; and

42
43 **WHEREAS,** the Property is not currently served by private or public water and
44 wastewater facilities, and the Property Owner desires to connect to City
45 public water and sewer lines to provide public water and sewer service to
46 allow completion of development, use and occupancy of the property; and

2 **WHEREAS,** the Property Owner will submit an application to the City pursuant to
3 Chapter 16.04 of the City Code, as may be amended, to obtain a permit
4 (“Permit”) to connect with the City water and sewer utility systems to
5 obtain water and sewer service for the Property, which Permit is
6 incorporated herein by reference; and
7

8 **WHEREAS,** it is the intention of the City that the City Department of Public Works
9 (the “Department”) shall not grant final approval for this connection to the
10 City water and sewer utility systems until such time as it shall be satisfied
11 that the proposed connection shall not result in or cause an inadequate
12 water flow to and/or sewage removal from the Property or to other
13 properties served by the affected City water and sewer utility lines and that
14 the proposed connection satisfies other requirements of the Department;
15 and
16

17 **WHEREAS,** the parties believe it to be in the public’s interest to permit the Property
18 Owner to connect to the City water and sewer utility systems; and
19

20 **WHEREAS,** Section 16.08.050A of the Code of the City of Annapolis requires the
21 passage of an ordinance before water service may be extended by written
22 agreement outside of the City limits; and
23

24 **WHEREAS,** pursuant to Section 16.08.050A of the Code of the City of Annapolis the
25 Director of Public Works has issued a determination, and upon same, the
26 City Council hereby finds that existing and/or funded facilities, capacity
27 and infrastructure are sufficient to serve 44 Hudson Street, LLC’s property
28 in addition to existing and reasonably foreseeable City users.

31 **SECTION I: BE IT ESTABLISHED AND ORDAINED BY THE ANNAPOLIS**
32 **CITY COUNCIL** that the Water and Sewer Service Agreement attached hereto be and
33 the same is hereby approved, adopted and authorized.

35 **SECTION II: AND BE IT FURTHER ESTABLISHED AND ORDAINED BY THE**
36 **ANNAPOLIS CITY COUNCIL** that this Ordinance shall take effect from the date of its
37 passage.

**CITY OF ANNAPOLIS
WATER AND SEWER SERVICE AGREEMENT**

THIS WATER AND SEWER SERVICE AGREEMENT (“Agreement”) is made this _____ day of _____, 2017, by and between the City of Annapolis, a municipal corporation of the State of Maryland (“City”), and 44 HUDSON STREET, LLC, a Maryland limited liability company, its successors and assigns (collectively, the “Property Owner”).

WHEREAS, the Property Owner is the fee simple owner of an improved parcel of land consisting of approximately 1.63 acres, more or less, located at 44 Hudson Street, Annapolis, Maryland 21401 and as more accurately described in a deed recorded at Liber 06463, folio 525 among the Land Records of Anne Arundel County (collectively, the “Property”), and with mailing addresses of 45 and 49 Hudson Street; and

WHEREAS, the Property is presently located outside the City limits of the City of Annapolis, and is presently under development pursuant to grading and building permits issued by Anne Arundel County for the construction of two (2) buildings intended for occupancy by commercial tenants; and

WHEREAS, the Property is not currently served by private or public water and wastewater facilities, and the Property Owner desires to connect to City public water and sewer lines to provide public water and sewer service to allow completion of development, use and occupancy of the property; and

WHEREAS, the Property Owner will submit an application to the City pursuant to Chapter 16.04 of the City Code, as may be amended, to obtain a permit (“Permit”) to connect with the City water and sewer utility systems to obtain water and sewer service for the Property, which Permit is incorporated herein by reference; and

WHEREAS, it is the intention of the City that the City Department of Public Works (the “Department”) shall not grant final approval for this connection to the City water and sewer utility systems until such time as it shall be satisfied that the proposed connection shall not result in or cause an inadequate water flow to and/or sewage removal from the Property or to other properties served by the affected City water and sewer utility lines and that the proposed connection satisfies other requirements of the Department; and

WHEREAS, the parties believe it to be in the public’s interest to permit the Property Owner to connect to the City water and sewer utility systems.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of these premises and the mutual covenants and promises set forth below, and other good and valuable consideration, the

1 receipt and sufficiency of which the parties acknowledge, the parties agree as follows:

2
3 **1. Design and Construction.**
4

5 a. The Property Owner, at its sole cost and expense, shall design and
6 construct, subject to written approval by the City and the Department, both water and
7 sewer connection systems with all related equipment and work necessary to provide
8 water and sewer service to the Property from the City water and sewer utility systems
9 (collectively, the "Connection Systems"). The Connection Systems shall be constructed
10 by the Property Owner pursuant to the City Code, as may be amended, and all City and
11 Department standards. The approved plans and/or drawings for the Connection Systems,
12 once completed, shall be attached hereto as **Attachment A**, upon completion and
13 approval by the City and the Department.
14

15 b. The Connection Systems shall comply with both Section 16.08.050 and
16 Chapter 16.16 of the City Code, as may be amended, and all other City and Department
17 requirements.
18

19 c. The Property Owner, at its sole cost and expense, shall submit all
20 applicable applications; obtain all applicable permits and approvals, including, but not
21 limited to, the Permit; enter into all applicable utility agreements; and obtain bonds in
22 form and substance as used by the City to accomplish the design and construction of the
23 Connection Systems. The Property Owner shall submit copies of all such applications,
24 permits, agreements and bonds to the Department, in such form as the Department in its
25 sole discretion may require.
26

27 d. The Property Owner, at its sole cost and expense, shall obtain from third
28 parties (including, but not limited to, adjacent property owners) such permission as the
29 City, in its sole discretion, may require to accomplish the purposes of this Agreement.
30 Such permission shall be in a form deemed acceptable to the City in its sole discretion.
31

32 e. The Property Owner, at its sole cost and expense, shall install back-flow
33 prevention (RPZ) devices inside the buildings on the Property to prevent back flow from
34 the water utility portion of the Connection Systems into the City water utility system.
35

36 **2. Easements; Provision of Water and Sewer Service.**
37

38 a. Upon the completion of all of the requirements set forth in Paragraph 1 by
39 the Property Owner, and the approval of the design and construction of the Connection
40 Systems by the City and the Department, the Property Owner shall convey to the City
41 such easements as the City may in its sole discretion require, including, but not limited to,
42 an access easement to the Connection Systems and any related water meter. Any and all
43 such easements shall be prepared and recorded at the sole cost and expense of the
44 Property Owner.
45

46 b. The City shall provide water and sewer utility service to the Property and

1 its improvements, all as reflected on a site plan to be attached hereto as part of
2 **Attachment A.**

3
4 c. The City shall provide a single water meter for the Property, which shall
5 be installed by the City at the Property Owner's sole cost and expense in such location(s)
6 as shall conform with all City requirements. This water meter shall remain the property of
7 the City.

8
9 d. The water and sewer utility service to be provided pursuant to this
10 Agreement shall be for domestic use only and not for fire protection.

11
12 e. The Property Owner shall not extend water or sewer utility lines installed
13 under this Agreement to any other property, building and/or structure without the prior
14 approval required by the Charter and Code of the City, as may be amended.

15
16 f. The City shall be obligated to provide water and sewer service to the
17 Property on the terms provided in this Agreement, and the Property Owner shall be
18 obligated to purchase all water and sewer utility services for the Property from the City.
19 Provided, however, that the City's obligation to provide water and sewer service under
20 this Agreement is specifically conditioned upon the Property Owner's performance of all
21 of its duties and responsibilities hereunder and any breach thereof by the Property Owner
22 or any decision by a judicial, quasi-judicial or administrative body invalidating any such
23 duty or responsibility shall relieve the City of its obligations and responsibilities under
24 this Agreement. The City's obligation to provide water and sewer utility service under
25 this Agreement is further expressly conditioned upon a finding by the Department that
26 providing water and sewer utility service to the Property shall not result in or cause an
27 inadequate water flow to and/or sewage removal from the Property and/or other
28 properties served by any affected water and sewer utility lines.

29
30 **3. Fees and Other Charges.**

31
32 a. The Property Owner shall pay all connection charges (including meter
33 costs) for the Property, as are customarily charged by the City for customers outside of
34 the City from time to time.

35
36 b. The Property Owner shall pay all capital facility charges and assessments
37 for water and sewer utility service to the Property, as are customarily charged by the City
38 for customers outside of the City from time to time.

39
40 c. For any calendar quarter (or any portion thereof) in which the Property
41 remains un-annexed into the City, the City shall charge and the Property Owner shall pay
42 on a per unit basis the same rate for water service and sewer service as is in effect for
43 customers outside of the City from time to time, and any other charges and fees required
44 by either Chapter 16.08 or Chapter 16.16 of the City Code, as may be amended.

45
46 d. Breach of any provision of this Paragraph 3, in addition to other remedies

provided herein, shall constitute a basis for temporary or permanent water and/or sewer utility service cut-off by the City to the Property.

4. Recordation; Binding.

a. It is expressly agreed that this Agreement shall be recorded among the Land Records of Anne Arundel County at the sole cost and expense of the Property Owner, and that the duties and responsibilities of this Agreement shall run with the title to the Property.

b. The parties and their respective successors, assigns and purchasers shall be entitled to all of the rights and privileges of this Agreement and shall be bound by all of its duties and responsibilities. All references to the "Property Owner" herein shall be interpreted to specifically refer to all of the Property Owner's successors, assigns and purchasers, without regard to privity with the City under this Agreement.

c. The terms of this Agreement shall be binding upon and shall inure to the benefit of the parties, any successor municipal authorities of the City or any successor quasi-governmental authority. Successor owners of record of the Property and/or the successors and assigns of the Property Owner may assign their benefits, rights, duties and obligations hereunder either as part of the conveyance of the Property as an entirety or severally as part of the conveyances of portions of the Property.

5. Inspections; Maintenance.

a. The Connection Systems, and any related specific devices installed as part of such Systems, shall be as approved by the Director of the Department.

b. At any time during normal business hours and upon reasonable notice of the City to the Property Owner, the Property Owner shall make the Property and the Connection Systems, as relates to this Agreement, available to the City, and its officials, officers, employees and agents, for inspection.

c. The Property Owner shall maintain and test the Connection Systems, at its sole cost and expense, on an annual basis.

d. Breach of any provision of this Paragraph 5, in addition to other remedies provided herein, shall constitute a basis for temporary or permanent water and/or sewer utility service cut-off by the City to the Property.

6. Indemnification.

a. The Property Owner shall forever indemnify, defend and hold harmless the City, its elected officials, appointees, directors, employees, agents, contractors and representatives from and against all liability for injuries to persons, including death, and damage to City property and other property arising from acts or omissions of the Property

1 Owner, its officers, agents, employees, contractors, patrons, volunteers, guests or invitees
2 resulting in connection with this Agreement, the Permit or the Connection Systems.

3
4 b. Property Owner indemnification does not limit any immunity which the
5 City, its elected officials, appointed officers, directors, employees, agents, contractors and
6 representatives are entitled to assert, and includes all costs and expenses, including
7 attorney's fees, whether or not related to administrative or judicial proceedings.

8
9 c. The City, in its sole discretion, may participate in handling its own defense
10 or exclusively handle its own defense, and select its own attorneys, including the City
11 Attorney. The indemnification for attorney fees applies whether or not the City Attorney
12 or other attorney handles the defense.

13
14 d. The Property Owner shall reimburse the City, within thirty (30) calendar
15 days after invoicing for such reimbursement, for any damage to the City's water and/or
16 sewer utility system, water mains, sewer mains, facilities, equipment or other property
17 caused by the negligence or willful misconduct of the Property Owner, its officers,
18 agents, employees, contractors, patrons, volunteers, guests or invitees.

19
20 **7. Breach/Default.**

21
22 a. Upon five (5) calendar days written notice from the City to the Property
23 Owner, the City may temporarily cut-off water and/or sewer utility service to the
24 Property if the Property Owner shall fail to fulfill in a timely and proper manner its
25 obligations under this Agreement, or if the Property Owner shall violate any term of this
26 Agreement. The City shall afford the Property Owner thirty (30) calendar days (or longer
27 as agreed to in writing by the City) to cure any breach or default of this Agreement before
28 permanently cutting-off water and/or sewer utility service to the Property.

29
30 b. The Property Owner shall be liable for any damage to the City resulting
31 from the Property Owner's breach or default of this Agreement, including, but not limited
32 to, any damages incurred by the City or the City water or sewer utility systems. In such
33 case, the City shall notify the Property Owner of the amount of its liability, which the
34 Property Owner shall pay within thirty (30) calendar days of such notice.

35
36 c. Upon the permanent cut-off of water and/or sewer utility service to the
37 Property for breach or default of this Agreement, the City shall reimburse the Property
38 Owner for any fees or charges paid in advance pursuant to Paragraph 3, prorated as of the
39 date of permanent cut-off, less the amount of damages caused by the breach or default, all
40 as determined by the City in its sole discretion. If the damages exceed any prorated
41 reimbursement, the City shall not be obligated to make any further prorated
42 reimbursements hereunder.

43
44 **8. Waiver.**

45
46 a. No delay or omission of the City to exercise any right, power or remedy

1 accruing upon the happening of an event that would allow the City to terminate this
2 Agreement shall impair any such right, power or remedy or shall constitute a waiver upon
3 the occurrence of another such event or any acquiescence therein. No delay or omission
4 on the part of the City to exercise any option granted to the City under this Agreement, in
5 any one or more instances shall constitute a waiver of the City's rights hereunder and
6 each such option shall remain continuously in full force and effect.

7
8 b. The Property Owner hereby understands and agrees that this Agreement
9 shall not waive any rights, powers or remedies that the City may have pursuant to the
10 City Code and, specifically, Chapter 16.04, Section 16.08.050 and Chapter 16.16 of the
11 City Code, all as may be amended.

12
13 **9. Annexation.**

14
15 At any time that the corporate boundaries of the City are amended such that the
16 Property becomes part of the City and/or the Property Owner successfully petitions the
17 City to annex the Property into the City's corporate boundaries pursuant to the Maryland
18 Annotated Code, water and sewer utility service shall be supplied to the Property under
19 such terms and conditions as are customarily imposed for customers located in the City.

20
21 **10. No Partnership.**

22
23 Nothing contained in this Agreement shall be construed in a manner to create any
24 relationship between the parties other than expressly specified herein, and the parties
25 shall not be considered partners or co-venturers for any purpose on account of this
26 Agreement.

27
28 **11. Severability.**

29
30 In the event any one or more of the provisions of this Agreement shall for any
31 reason be held by a court or other lawful authority to be invalid, illegal or unenforceable,
32 in whole or in part or in any other respect, the remaining provisions hereof shall not be
33 affected thereby, and the Agreement shall remain operative and in full force and effect
34 and shall in no way be affected, prejudiced or disturbed thereby.

35
36 **12. Governing Law.**

37
38 This Agreement and its interpretation shall be governed by Maryland law. The
39 venue for all actions pursuant to this Agreement shall be the Courts of Anne Arundel
40 County, Maryland. The parties waive trial by jury in all actions brought pursuant to this
41 Agreement.

42
43 **13. Captions and Headings.**

44
45 The captions and headings contained in this Agreement are included herein for
46 convenience of reference only and shall not be considered a part hereof and are not in any

way intended to limit or enlarge the terms hereof.

14. Integration; Modification.

a. This Agreement is the final and entire agreement of the parties concerning all matters having to do with the Permit and the Connection Systems. The parties acknowledge that there are no other understandings or representations, oral or written, regarding the subject or matters having to do with the Permit and/or the Connection Systems.

b. None of the terms or provisions of this Agreement may be changed, waived, or modified exempt by written instrument executed by both parties hereto.

15. Counterparts.

This Agreement may be executed in any number of counterparts and by the parties hereto in separate counterparts, each of which when so executed and delivered shall be deemed to be an original and all of which taken together shall constitute but one and the same instrument.

16. Notice.

Any notice required to be delivered shall be deemed to have been received when the notice has been sent by certified mail, return receipt, overnight carrier, or hand delivered with signed receipt to the following address and individual or such other address and/or such other individual as a party may identify in writing to the other party:
