15 **Filing of Grant Application with the Maryland Transit Administration**

16 **FOR** the purpose of authorizing the filing of an application with the Maryland Transit
17 Administration of the Maryland Department of Transportation for a Section 5303, 5304,
18 5307, 5309, 5310, 5311, 5316 and/or 5317 grant(s) under the Federal Transit Act for a total
19 amount of **\$3,890,545**, consisting of \$2,554,554 for fixed route transit operations;
20 \$215,232 for ADA complementary paratransit services; \$427,500 capital grant for transit
21 vehicle maintenance; and \$693,259 capital grant for the purchase of two (2) heavy duty
22 buses for replacement purposes.

23 **WHEREAS,** the Maryland Transit Administration is the designated recipient in Maryland for
24 grants under the Federal Transit Act; and

25 **WHEREAS,** the Administrator of the Maryland Transit Administration of the Maryland
26 Department of Transportation is authorized to make grants to counties and to local
27 governments for public transportation programs or projects; and

28 **WHEREAS,** the contract for financial assistance will impose certain obligations upon the
29 applicant, including the provision by it of the local share of the project costs in
30 the program; and

31 **WHEREAS,** it is required by the United States Department of Transportation in accordance
32 with the provisions of Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 that, in connection
33 with the filing of an application for assistance under the Federal Transit Act, the
34 applicant give an assurance that it will comply with Title VI of the Civil Rights
35 Act of 1964 and the United States Department of Transportation requirements
36 thereunder; and

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WHEREAS, it is the goal of the applicant that minority business enterprise be utilized to the fullest extent possible in connection with this project, and that definite procedures shall be established and administered to ensure that minority business shall have the maximum construction contracts, supplies, equipment contracts, or consultant and other services.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ANNAPOLIS CITY COUNCIL that the filing of the application referred to above is hereby approved.

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED BY THE ANNAPOLIS CITY COUNCIL that a copy of this resolution be sent to the Maryland Transit Administration of the Maryland Department of Transportation.
