35		facility as determined by the Finance Director in a Fiscal Impact Note, plus	
36		all costs incurred by the City of Annapolis including, but not limited to,	
37		utility costs and costs associated with municipal services (public safety,	
38		public works, custodial, renovations, repairs, maintenance, transportation	
39		and parking)"; and
