EACH RETIRED MEMBER'S PENSION SHALL BE INCREASED BY THE SAME PERCENTAGE AS ANY INCREASE IN THE PAY SCALE FOR MEMBERS OF THE SAME RANK AND YEARS OF SERVICE WHO ARE ON ACTIVE DUTY.
