31 **WHEREAS**, pursuant to Chapter 1.20 – General Penalty and Municipal Infractions,
32 fines are authorized in the City Code and established by resolution of the
33 City Council; and

35 **WHEREAS**, Ordinance O-37-15 removes the 15-minute parking zone on Northwest
36 Street; and

38 **WHEREAS**, Ordinance O-38-15 establishes Section 12.20.115 regulating the parking
39 of Motor Homes on City streets.
