Amendment 1-5, Buckley

Amendment 1:

On page 11, strike lines 41 down through 42 and substitute:

- “xii. ~~Director of~~ Human Resources MANAGER
- xiii. Management Information Technology ~~Director~~MANAGER.”

Amendment 2:

On page 12, strike lines 25-26 and insert “Health Officer, and except with regard to Section 10.12.160, which matters shall be administered and enforced by the DEPUTY CITY MANAGER FOR RESILIENCE AND SUSTAINABILITY.” and in line 31 after “Zoning” insert “AND THE DEPUTY CITY MANAGER FOR RESILIENCE AND SUSTAINABILITY”

Amendment 3:

On page 14, in line 8 unstrike “Director of Planning and Zoning or his or her designee” and strike “CITY FORESTER” ; and strike lines 34 down through “CITY FORESTER” in line 38 and insert in lieu thereof “In issuing a permit, the Director of Planning and Zoning or his or her designee may, in its discretion, require that replacement tree(s) be planted. The size, location and variety of any replacement tree may be required by the Director of Planning and Zoning or his or her designee, solely at his or her discretion”

Rationale: The Environmentalist/City Forester position will move to Planning and Zoning and may be the Director of Planning and Zoning designee.

Amendment 4:

On page 15, in lines 5-6, 22-23, and 28 unstrike “Director of Planning and Zoning” and strike “CITY FORESTER” and in line 30 unstrike “director or designee” and strike “CITY FORESTER”; on page 16 in lines 11-12, and 22 unstrike “Director of Planning and Zoning” and strike “CITY FORESTER”

Rationale: The Environmentalist/City Forester position will move to Planning and Zoning and may be the Director of Planning and Zoning designee.

Amendment 5:

On page 17, in line 21 strike “from the date of its passage” and insert “ON THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF CA-1-20”
