4		special exception shall expire. However, the Board of Appeals, in its discretion and upon
5		a showing of good cause, may grant up to two successive extensions of the granting of
6		the special exception for periods of not longer than six monthsone year each; provided
7		that, a written request for each extension is filed while the prior grant is still valid.

9	<u>C.</u>	Cessation of Special Exception Use. A special exception expires if it ceases for more
10		than six months. In the case of a building or structure which is destroyed or damaged by
11		fire or other casualty or act of God, the Planning and Zoning Director may approve the
12		reestablishment of the use provided that restoration is actively and diligently pursued to
13		completion in a timely fashion.
14		1. A special exception expires if:
15		a. The special exception ceases for more than six months after issuance of a
16		use permit for the special exception use; or
17		b. Prior to the issuance of a use permit for the special exception use, grading
18		or building work pursuant to a grading or building permit to implement the
