13 **A RESOLUTION** concerning

14 **Establishing the Order of Succession for Mayor**

15 **FOR** the purpose of establishing the order of succession for Mayor Jared Littmann if he is
16 unable to serve due to temporary disability or absence from the City for longer than one
17 day.

20 **WHEREAS,** Establishing a clear line of succession for the Mayor is essential in case the Mayor
21 is unable to serve due to temporary disability or absence from the City for longer
22 than one day; and
23

24 **WHEREAS,** Article V, Section 3(c) of the City of Annapolis Charter states, "[n]o later than the
25 fourth council meeting after the mayor and aldermen/alderwomen take office, the
26 city council shall, by resolution, designate the successive order of each current
27 alderman/alderwoman beginning with the alderman/alderwoman who has served
28 the longest length of time on the city council and ending with the
29 alderman/alderwoman who has served the shortest length of time on the city
30 council."; and

32 **WHEREAS,** The City Council finds it suitable to designate a succession order based on the
33 length of continuous service as an Alderman or Alderwoman as required by
34 Article V, Section 3 of the Charter; and

36 **WHEREAS,** This succession plan is essential to ensuring the seamless continuity of our
37 municipal government and effective leadership.

39 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ANNAPOLIS CITY COUNCIL** that in
40 the event the Mayor is unable to serve temporarily due to disability or absence from the City for

1 longer than one day, the following Aldermen and Alderwomen shall succeed to perform the
2 duties of Mayor in the following order, based on their length of continuous service:

- 3 1. Alderman Robert Savidge, Ward 7
- 4 2. Alderman Brooks Schandelmeier, Ward 5
- 5 3. Alderwoman Karma O'Neill, Ward 2
- 6 4. Alderman Harry Huntley, Ward 1
- 7 5. Alderman Keanuú Smith-Brown, Ward 3
- 8 6. Alderwoman Janice Allsup-Johnson, Ward 4
- 9 7. Alderwoman Diesha Contee, Ward 6
- 10 8. Alderman Frank Thorp, Ward 8

12 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED BY THE ANNAPOLIS CITY COUNCIL** that

- 13 1. Seniority shall be determined by length of continuous service on the City Council. In the
14 event two or more members have equal length of service, seniority shall be determined
15 by the ranking in this resolution, as required by Article V, Section 3(c) of the City of
16 Annapolis Charter.
- 17 2. The first available member in the order of succession who is able to serve shall assume
18 the duties of Mayor until the Mayor can resume duties or a new Mayor is elected or
19 appointed according to applicable City law.

21 **AND BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED BY THE ANNAPOLIS CITY COUNCIL** that this
22 resolution shall take effect upon passage.
