FOR the purpose of correcting a typographical error in the FY 2024 Fines Schedule for the City of Annapolis Plastic Bag Reduction Act fines.

WHEREAS, Resolution 14-24 (R-14-24), which establishes the fines for violations of the City of Annapolis Plastic Bag Reduction Act, was adopted on October 14, 2024. However, the resolution contained an incorrect section number that had been changed in the Plastic Bag Reduction Act authorization ordinance (O-5-24) during the drafting process, but this change was not reflected in the accompanying fines resolution.
