

LEGISLATIVE SUMMARY

O-3-24

City Council Nominations to Boards, Commissions, and Committees

This summary was prepared by the City of Annapolis Office of Law for use by members of the Annapolis City Council during consideration of the legislation.

BACKGROUND

Throughout the City Code, under sections that create the various boards, commissions, and committee of the City, there is a variation of the following statement: "The [name of board, commission, committee] shall be appointed by the Mayor and confirmed by the City Council."

But not every section creating the board, commission, or board includes what to do if a position remains vacant a long time.

BILL SUMMARY

O-3-24 allows City Council members to appoint a nominee to fill vacant positions on City boards, commissions, and committees.

The position must be vacant, or filled by a temporary appointment, at least six months.

The nomination must be presented to the Council as a resolution that will be voted upon after the second reading of the resolution.
