1	 Privacy fences or other fences with less than two inches gap between boards,
2	excluding lattice-type fencing, shall not be installed along areas that are backed
3	on one side, the applicant's side, by forests or open space that does not have
4	homes located on or within 50 feet of the fence.
5	 Undue obstructions could include, but are not limited to, fences that are over four
6	feet tall that include no lattice or have gaps smaller than two inches between
7	boards, that are proposed to be located within 10 feet of a neighboring property's
8	rear windows or that are backing undeveloped forest.
9 10 11	3. Fences located on up-slopes behind homes may be more obstructive to light and air and should be modified as needed to alleviate this issue, especially when there are no homes on the applicant's side of the fence.
