AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED BY THE ANNAPOLIS CITY COUNCIL that the term of all members of the Commission shall end with the publication of its report, the members shall serve without compensation, the members shall elect from among their membership a Chair, vice chair and secretary, the Commission meetings shall be held publicly by the Maryland Open Meetings Act and Robert's Rules of Order, and testimony shall be taken from the public on at least one occasion.

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED BY THE ANNAPOLIS CITY COUNCIL that this resolution shall take effect upon passage.
