16 **A RESOLUTION** concerning

17  
18 **City Sponsored Special Events in Fiscal Year 2022**

19  
20 **FOR** the purpose of identifying City Sponsored Special Events; and waiving certain  
21 related City Fees during Fiscal Year 2022.

23  
24 **WHEREAS,** Section 14.18.020 of the City Code defines a “City Sponsored Event” as “a  
25 special event that:

- 26 1. the city council approves by resolution as a city sponsored event;  
27 2. enures solely to the benefit of the public, with no profit or emolument  
28 to the City to thereby serve a governmental function; and  
29 3. benefits the public health, safety and welfare to thereby serve a  
30 governmental purpose”; and

31  
32 **WHEREAS,** Section 6.04.210 of the City Code states that “whenever a person leases,  
33 uses or occupies a City facility, the person shall be charged and pay a  
34 minimum of full fees for the use of the facility.” Examples of City facilities  
35 include public spaces, grounds, parks, athletic facilities, fields, docks, piers,  
36 wet slips, moorings, developable waters, buildings, motor vehicles,  
37 equipment, structures, rooms or other parts of public buildings. Examples  
38 of City services include traffic control, crowd control, public safety support  
39 (police or fire), trash removal, sanitary services, recycling, bulk pick-up, the  
40 provision of water, sewer, electricity, communications or other utilities,  
41 transportation, and labor. Full fees “means the value of the right to lease,  
42 use or occupy the City facility as determined by the Finance Director in a  
43 fiscal impact note, plus all costs incurred by the City of Annapolis  
44 including, but not limited to, utility costs and costs associated with

1 municipal services (public safety, public works, custodial, renovations,  
2 repairs, maintenance, transportation and parking)”; and

4 **WHEREAS**, Section 6.04.210 of the City Code further states that the fees for City  
5 Services may be waived “by resolution of the City Council pursuant to  
6 guidelines approved by the City Council.”

9 **NOW THEREFORE**,

10  
11 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ANNAPOLIS CITY COUNCIL** that the following  
12 Special Events are designated City Sponsored Special Events during Fiscal Year 2022, in  
13 recognition of their significance to our heritage and public service to our City:  
14

- 15 • Martin Luther King, Jr. Parade and Diaspora Concert and Festival
- 16 • St. Patrick’s Day Parade
- 17 • Memorial Day Parade
- 18 • Independence Day Parade
- 19 • Elk’s Pre-Labor Day Parade
- 20 • Kunta Kinte Festival
- 21 • Tug of War
- 22 • Grand Illumination
- 23 • Lights Parade
- 24 • New Year’s Eve Celebration

26 **AND, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED BY THE ANNAPOLIS CITY COUNCIL** that  
27 there shall be a waiver of certain fees for the designated City Sponsored Special Events  
28 that are identified in the Staff Report attached to this Resolution and incorporated by  
29 reference.

31 **AND, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED BY THE ANNAPOLIS CITY COUNCIL** that  
32 this resolution shall take effect from the date of its passage.
