Amendment 4 changes the enactment date for O-17-25.

MOTION:

In the Section dealing with the effective date of O-17-25 (Section II or Section III), strike "upon passage" and insert "in 2 years, and in areas with short-term rentals above the 10% cap, no short-term rental permits shall be renewed or issued during this period.

As the changes would look in the Ordinance:

SECTION II: AND BE IT FURTHER ESTABLISHED AND ORDAINED BY THE ANNAPOLIS CITY COUNCIL that this ordinance shall take effect upon passage in two years, and in areas with short-term rentals above the 10% cap, no short-term rental permits shall be renewed or issued during this period.
