and empowering the City of Annapolis (the "City") to

issue and sell, upon its full faith and credit, (i) one or

more series of its general obligation bonds in the

aggregate principal amount not to exceed \$26,616,084

(the "Bonds"), pursuant to Sections 19-301 through

19-309, inclusive, of the Local Government Article of

the Annotated Code of Maryland, as amended, and

Article VII, Section 11 of the Charter of the City of

Annapolis, as amended (the "Charter"), (ii) one or

more series of its general obligation bond anticipation

notes in anticipation of the issuance of the Bonds in

the maximum aggregate principal amount equal to the

maximum aggregate principal amount of the Bonds

(the "Notes"), pursuant to Sections 19-211 through

19-221, inclusive, of the Local Government Article of

the Annotated Code of Maryland, as amended and the

Charter and (iii) one or more series of its general

obligation bonds to refund specified bonds previously
