On page 4, strike lines 11 through 16 and insert the following:

- “b. The Finance Committee shall review and make recommendations on the Mayor's annual operating budget; submit recommendations regarding the budget to the City Council not later than the second Monday in May of each year; review all proposed amendments to Title 6 (Revenue and Finance) of this Code.”

Section 2.16.190 - Standing Committees

A. The following standing committees of the City Council are designated, which shall review and make recommendations with regard to matters referred to them and shall perform other general duties and responsibilities:

1. **Finance Committee.**

- a. The Finance Committee shall consider matters relating to the review and continuous surveillance of the budget.
- b. The Finance Committee shall review and make recommendations on the Mayor's annual operating budget; submit recommendations regarding the budget to the City Council not later than the second Monday in May of each year; review all proposed amendments to Title 6 (Revenue and Finance) of this Code.
