15	A RESOLUTION concerning

17	Support for the United States Supreme Court Decision in the Case of Roe v. Wade
18	
19	FOR the purpose of expressing support for the Supreme Court Decision in the case of
20	Roe v. Wade and generally expressing support for women's right to an abortion in
21	the United States.
22	
23	WHEREAS, May 2, 2022, a leaked initial draft majority draft opinion written by Justice
24	Samuel Alito indicated that the United States Supreme Court is prepared to overturn Roe
25	v. Wade (1973) and Planned Parenthood v. Casey (1992) (overruled certain portions of
26	Roe) in a final decision on Dobbs v. Jackson Women's Health Organization
27	
28	WHEREAS, thousands of Annapolitans expressed outrage in fear of the Supreme
29	Court's final decision
30	
31	WHEREAS, the Supreme Court case of <i>Planned Parenthood v. Casey</i> , re-emphasized
32	the right to an abortion, upholding the "essential holding" in <i>Roe</i> " that Constitutional
33	protection of the woman's decision to terminate her pregnancy derives from the Due
34	Process Clause of the Fourteenth Amendment, which declares that no State shall "deprive
35	any person of life, liberty, or property, without due process of law - liberty being the
36	controlling word; and
37	
38	WHEREAS, in 1992 61% of Marylanders voted to support SB 162 which made clear
39	the State may not interfere with the decision of a woman to terminate a pregnancy before
40	fetal viability. Protecting a women's right to abortion in the State of Maryland; and
41	
42	WHEREAS, The Supreme Court in the <i>Roe v. Wade</i> decision ruled that the Due Process
43	Clause of the Fourteenth Amendment to the U.S Constitution, enshrines a right to privacy
44	that ultimately protects a pregnant woman's liberty to choose to have an abortion; and

1	WHEREAS, in a poll conducted by the Pew Research Center, 64% of Marylanders 18
2	years of age and older agreed that abortion should be legal in all or most cases, and
3	
4	WHEREAS, the number of abortion clinics and access to prenatal care has diminished in
5	the state in recent years, going from 52 in 1982 to 51 in 1992, and now in 2022 less than
6	20; and
7	
8	WHEREAS, the late Speaker of the House the Honorable Michael E. Busch stated in
9	2019, "Given the current national climate, the change in the makeup of the Supreme
10	Court and the alarming increase in anti-choice legislation introduced in Maryland, it is
11 12	important to protect this right in Maryland's constitution"
13	NOW, THEREFORE,
14	NOW, THEREFORE,
15	BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ANNAPOLIS CITY COUNCIL that the City of
16	Annapolis expresses its support for a woman's right to an abortion in the United States and
17	for a decision by the U.S. Supreme Court upholding its decision in Roe v. Wade.
18	
19	AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED BY THE ANNAPOLIS CITY COUNCIL that
20	a copy of this Resolution shall be sent to the District 30 State Delegation expressing support
21	for continued funding of women's health facilities in the State of Maryland and an update
22	on the constitutional amendment to protect a women's right to choose.
