**Legislation Title:** Alcoholic Beverages – Refillable Container License Fees

**Description:** For the purpose of specifying the fees that will be charged for Class E license holders authorized to sell draft beer in refillable containers.

**Analysis of Fiscal Impact:** Section 7.12.280 of the City Code requires that fees for alcoholic beverage licenses be set by resolution of the Annapolis City Council. This resolution would allow the Alcohol Beverage Control Board to issue Class E license holders a class of license that authorizes refillable containers, for a fee of \$50 if the applicant already has an off-sale privilege or \$500 if the applicant does not already have that privilege. There were six (6) Class E licenses issued for use in the City for 2015, and two (2) of these licenses have off-sale privileges. In the event that all six opt to obtain a Class E license, the maximum annual impact would be \$2,100.
