18 **A RESOLUTION** concerning

19 **“Thompson Street Park”**

21 **FOR** the purpose of designating specific City of Annapolis-owned property as a street-
22 end park; naming the street-end park at the southeast end of Thompson Street the
23 “Thompson Street Park”; and generally relating to park amenities.

25 **WHEREAS,** the City of Annapolis is working to create green space and parks that are accessible
26 to the general public; and

27
28 **WHEREAS,** Thompson Street ends at Old Woman’s Cove off of Spa Creek at a city-owned
29 property that is used for dingy docking, fishing, and viewing Spa Creek;

30
31 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ANNAPOLIS CITY COUNCIL** that the
32 City-owned property located at the southeast end of Thompson Street Annapolis, Maryland, be
33 designated a street-end park named “Thompson Street Park.”

35 **AND, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED BY THE ANNAPOLIS CITY COUNCIL** that park
36 amenities be installed as included in the adopted budget of the City Council with the understanding
37 that public water access to Old Woman’s Cove from Thompson Street Park will be provided
38 contingent upon its feasibility.

40 **AND, BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED BY THE ANNAPOLIS CITY COUNCIL** that such
41 street end park dedication shall take effect upon the passage of this Resolution.
