**Legislation Title:** Amending Parking Fines for Repeat or Continuous Violations

**Description:** For the purpose of removing a graduated fines structure for repeat violations; adding a multiplier for repeat violations; and matters relating to amending special residential parking district fines imposed for parking violations.

### **Analysis of Fiscal Impact:**

This legislation removes the fine multiplier for parking violations as outlined in Section 12.32.190 A of the City Code (\$70.00 for second violation in one year; \$105.00 for third violation in one year; \$140 for fourth and fifth violation in one year). The fine will stay at a fixed rate of two times the daily maximum garage fee for violations one through five. After a fifth violation is incurred, the vehicle may be impounded until all outstanding parking fines are paid. The removal of the multiplier will result in reduced revenues for multiple offenses. However, with the implementation of License Plate Recognition (LPR) equipped vehicles, it is anticipated that the increased volume of enforcement activity will negate any loss as a result of eliminating the multiplier.
