**City Supported Special Events in Fiscal Year 2026**

**AMENDMENT 1 – ALD. HUNTLEY**

**(On Behalf of the Finance Committee)**

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**Amendment Summary:**

Amendment 1 states that if final fees exceed the City's estimated waiver by 10% or more, those fees must be reviewed by the Council before being waived.

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**MOTION:**

On page 2, in line 1, insert the following new "resolved" paragraph:

**"AND, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED BY THE ANNAPOLIS CITY COUNCIL** that if the actual city service fees exceed the estimated amount in the staff Fiscal Impact Note by 10% or more, the fee waiver for that event shall be revoked, and the request must be presented to the Council for approval."

**AND, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED BY THE ANNAPOLIS CITY COUNCIL** that the following Special Events are designated City Supported Special Events during Fiscal Year 2026 in recognition of their significance to our heritage and public service to our City:

- Independence Day Parade (July)
- Family Day Festival (July)
- Elk's Pre-Labor Day Parade (September)
- Kunta Kinte Heritage Festival (September)
- Tug of War (November)
- Veterans Day Ceremony (November)

- Grand Illumination (November)
- Annapolis Holiday Market (December)
- Lights Parade (December)
- New Year's Eve Celebration (December)
- St. Patrick's Day Parade Weekend Events; Hooley and Shamrock the Dock (March)
- Annapolis Film Festival (March)
- Martin Luther King, Jr. Parade (April)
- African Diaspora Concert and Festival (April/May)
- Memorial Day Parade (May)
- Annapolis Pride Parade and Festival (June)
- Juneteenth Parade and Festival (June)

**AND, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED BY THE ANNAPOLIS CITY COUNCIL** that there shall be a waiver of certain fees for the designated City Supported Special Events identified in the Staff Report attached to this Resolution and incorporated by reference.

**AND, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED BY THE ANNAPOLIS CITY COUNCIL** that if the actual city service fees exceed the estimated amount in the staff Fiscal Impact Note by 10% or more, the fee waiver for that event shall be revoked, and the request must be presented to the Council for approval.

**AND, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED BY THE ANNAPOLIS CITY COUNCIL** that this resolution shall take effect from the date of its passage.
