**Legislation Title:** **Parking Enforcement and Rulemaking Responsibilities**

**Description:** For the purpose of updating parking enforcement and rulemaking responsibilities in Chapters 2.36, 12.08, and 12.32 in the Code of the City of Annapolis; and matters generally relating to updating parking enforcement and rulemaking responsibilities.

**Analysis of Fiscal Impact:** In February 2016 the City entered into a Management Agreement with Central Parking System of Maryland, Inc. (also known as SP+) to manage certain parking matters within City limits, which include parking meters, garages, parking lots, residential permits, parking enforcement (including towing), installation of new equipment/technologies, and various studies related to parking matters. This legislation would allow SP+ to perform its obligations per the Management Agreement, and to also clarify other conflicts between existing Code sections as to which department possesses responsibilities for these matters. There is no fiscal impact associated with this legislation.
