18 **AN ORDINANCE** concerning

19
20 **Removing Archwood and Smith from Parking District 3**

21
22 **FOR** the purpose of removing certain blocks of Archwood Avenue and Smith Avenue
23 from Special Residential Parking District 3.

24
25 **BY** repealing and re-enacting with amendments the following portions of the Code of
26 the City of Annapolis, 2016 Edition
27 Section 12.32.170

28
29 **WHEREAS,** Section 12.32.030 of the Code of the City of Annapolis provides that
30 residents may petition the Transportation Board to create, alter, or
31 eliminate Special Residential Parking Districts (SRPDs); and

32
33 **WHEREAS,** residents of Archwood Avenue living within SRPD 3 petitioned the
34 Transportation Board to remove their block from the Parking District on
35 December 15, 2016; and

36
37 **WHEREAS,** residents of Smith Ave living within SRPD 3 petitioned the Transportation
38 Board to remove their block from the Parking District on January 17,
39 2017; and

40
41 **WHEREAS,** residents of both streets have experienced no lack of parking supply on
42 these streets and believe the existing restrictions are unnecessary; and

43
44 **WHEREAS,** the petitions were virtually unanimously supported by residents on both
45 streets; and

1 **WHEREAS**, the Transportation Board received these petitions at their meeting on
2 January 25, 2017, deliberated upon them, and voted to recommend the
3 requested changes to the City Council; and
4

5 **WHEREAS**, the Transportation Board notified the Council on January 27, 2017; and
6

7 **WHEREAS**, Sections 12.32.050 and 12.32.060 of the Annapolis City Code require the
8 City Council to prominently post notice within the area under
9 consideration, hold an advertised public hearing, and act upon the
10 Transportation Board's recommendation by Ordinance within 60 days.
11

12 **SECTION I: BE IT ESTABLISHED AND ORDAINED BY THE ANNAPOLIS**
13 **CITY COUNCIL** that the Code of the City of Annapolis shall be amended to read as
14 follows:
15

16 **CHAPTER 12.32 – SPECIAL RESIDENTIAL PARKING DISTRICTS**
17

18 **12.32.170 Special residential parking district No. 3.**
19

20 A. There is created a special residential parking district No. 3. The following areas and
21 streets are designated to be within this special residential parking district as shown
22 on Map 12.32.170:
23

24 Southside of West Street from Church Circle to Monticello Avenue;

25 Shaw from Lafayette to Franklin;

26 Dean;

27 City Gate;

28 Larkin;

29 Water;

30 Franklin, from Cathedral to Spa Creek;

31 North and South Acton;

32 Murray;

33 Colonial, from Murray to Steele Avenue;

34 Morris;

35 Lafayette, from West to Monticello;

36 Steele;

37 Stehle;

38 Stewart;

39 Southgate;

40 Thompson;

41 Cheston;

42 Taney;

43 Monticello Avenue from West Street to Stehle Street;

44 Brooke Avenue;

45 Amos Garrett Boulevard from Academy Street to West Street (not including sections
46 in the MX zone);

1 Academy Street from Amos Garrett Boulevard to Archwood Avenue;
2 ~~Archwood Avenue from Academy Street to Stehle Street;~~
3 ~~Smith Avenue from Chase Street to Amos Garrett Boulevard;~~
4 Granville Avenue;
5 Constitution Avenue;
6 Constitution Square; and
7 German Street.

8
9 B. A City resident living on a corner adjacent to a street located in residential parking
10 district No. 3, but whose street address is not included in the residential parking
11 district shall have the option of purchasing a residential parking permit.

12
13 C. On the streets listed below, parking is limited to two hours per day between the hours
14 of eight a.m. and midnight, seven days a week, inclusive, unless the vehicle parked
15 within this area displays the special residential parking permit or is otherwise
16 registered with the City and the authorized agent as a permit holder.

18 Dean Street;
19 Shaw Street;
20 City Gate Lane;
21 Water Street;
22 Larkin Street;
23 German Street;
24 Colonial Avenue, from Murray to Southgate Avenue;
25 Morris Street;
26 Murray Avenue from Colonial to Lafayette; and
27 Lafayette Street from West to Murray.

28
29 D. On other streets, parking is limited to two hours per day between the hours of eight
30 a.m. to six p.m. Monday through Friday, inclusive, unless the vehicle parked within
31 this area displays the special residential parking permit or is otherwise registered
32 with the City and the authorized agent as a permit holder.

33
34 E. 1. Subject to paragraph 2, addresses in the MX Zoning District are not eligible for
35 special residential parking permits.

36
37 2. (i) Residents of existing buildings along West Street from Church Circle to
38 Madison Place are eligible for a permit in either of the adjoining parking
39 districts if: (a) the building was constructed prior to the establishment of the
40 MX zone; (b) the ground floor is used for commercial purposes; and (c)
41 there is no on-site parking.


42 (ii) Residents of single-family dwellings or single-family attached dwellings
43 that were constructed prior to November 14, 2016, are eligible for permits.
44

- 1 F. Residences located on Franklin Street between Shaw and Cathedral, on the boundary
- 2 of Parking Districts 2 and 3, are eligible for a permit in one district or the other, but
- 3 not both.
