19 **Annapolis All-Stars Youth Sports Program Fee Waiver**

21 **FOR** the purpose of waiving certain City of Annapolis fees for the Annapolis All-Stars
22 II, Inc., a youth sports program.

24 **WHEREAS,** The Annapolis All-Stars is a youth sports program started in 1989 by
25 Stanford and Shirley Womack; and

26
27 **WHEREAS,** The program began with two football teams in 1989 and grew to eight
28 football teams, 13 basketball teams, six baseball teams and four
29 cheerleading teams; and

31 **WHEREAS,** The All-Stars was disbanded in 2001 and restarted in 2022 under the current
32 name, Annapolis All Stars II, Inc., to offer seasonal sports with the goal of
33 teaching values of accountability, leadership, sportsmanship, work ethics in
34 the classroom and on the playing fields; and

36 **WHEREAS,** Along with playing field sports, the young team members also hear from
37 motivational speakers, meet professional athletes, go on field trips to local
38 colleges; and

40 **WHEREAS,** The All-Stars athletic program currently has a T-ball and Coach pitch
41 leagues for both boys and girls, which started in April, and plan to have
42 tackle football, flag football and cheerleading in the Fall.
