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Bonded Employees

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FOR the purpose of providing that as a substitute for a bond, the City Council may
authorize the City to insure the Director of Finance and the Assistant Director for
Accounting under a Government Crime Policy.

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**SECTION I: BE IT ESTABLISHED AND ORDAINED BY THE ANNAPOLIS
CITY COUNCIL** that the Code of the City of Annapolis shall be amended to read as
follows:

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Chapter 2.20 – DIRECTOR OF FINANCE

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Section 2.20.010 - Bond.

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Before the Director of Finance enters upon the discharge of the duties of the
office, the director shall give bond to the City with a corporate surety to be approved by
the City Council, in the penal sum of one hundred thousand dollars, conditioned upon the
faithful discharge of the duties of the office. The premium for the bond shall be paid by
the City. The City Council at any time may demand of the Director of Finance other or
further bond, with other or further security, as in its judgment the interest of the City
requires. **IN THE ALTERNATIVE, AND AS A SUBSTITUTE FOR A BOND, THE**

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1 CITY COUNCIL MAY AUTHORIZE THE CITY TO INSURE THE DIRECTOR OF
2 FINANCE UNDER A GOVERNMENT CRIME POLICY.

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4 **Section 2.20.020 - Assistant Director for Accounting.**

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6 A. There shall be appointed by the Director of Finance a person of sound
7 discretion to perform the several non-budget related duties appertaining to this office,
8 who shall be styled "Assistant Director for Accounting." The Assistant Director for
9 Accounting, before entering on the discharge of the duties of office, shall give bond to
10 the City with a corporate surety, to be approved by the City Council, in the penal sum of
11 one hundred thousand dollars, conditioned upon the faithful discharge of the duties of
12 office and the keeping and performing of the trust reposed or which may be reposed in as
13 Assistant Director for Accounting. The premium for the bond shall be paid by the City.
14 The City Council at any time may demand of the Assistant Director for Accounting other
15 or further security as in its judgment the interest of the City requires. **IN THE**
16 **ALTERNATIVE, AND AS A SUBSTITUTE FOR A BOND, THE CITY COUNCIL**
17 **MAY AUTHORIZE THE CITY TO INSURE THE ASSISTANT DIRECTOR FOR**
18 **ACCOUNTING UNDER A GOVERNMENT CRIME POLICY.**

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20 B. The Assistant Director for Accounting shall have the same powers and
21 obligations and shall perform all the non-budget-related duties performed by the Director
22 of Finance, in the absence of the director, as authorized by law, and all the non-budget-
23 related duties assigned to the Assistant Director for Accounting by the City Council and
24 the Director of Finance.

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27 **SECTION II: AND BE IT FURTHER ESTABLISHED AND ORDAINED BY**
28 **THE ANNAPOLIS CITY COUNCIL** that this ordinance shall take effect from the date
29 of its passage.
