- 2. The Council hereby authorizes the Department to develop and publish regulations to implement this provision, which shall specify how tier measurements are made and how adjacent property owners shall be held accountable for the snow removal fees and fines. Said regulations shall be published by the Department within 90 days of passage of this Ordinance; and
- 3. This resolution shall be effective on the date of its adoption.
