Presentation to City of Annapolis

Focus area: Madison Apartments and Tyler Heights neighborhorhood.... And then included Latino families affected by shootings. With the OCS's approval, we shifted our focus to include working directly with the Latino families affected by shootings this summer in Annapolis. Our revised project aimed to provide comprehensive support, addressing their immediate needs and assisting in their healing process. By leveraging our existing resources and expertise, we ensured that the families we worked with received the necessary social services, legal support, and access to healthcare and mental health services. We have been able to support families with financial assistance and access to food, helped them to sign up for food assistance, and have connected them to mental health resources as well.


What did we do?

- 1) Presented Mental Health Portal and information on local and county resources to community members
- 2) Bilingual presence: We developed a consistent resource table to engage with the Madison Apartments community, and provided information to each unit in Madison apartments.
- 3) As a phase two of engagement, we created a 20 minute needs assessment survey, that 90 individuals participated in, from Madison Apartments and Tyler Heights and we want to continue to take this across the City.
- 4) Provided Case Management support with access to services, filling out applications, following up on applications with DSS, SSA, and AG's.
- 5) Mental Health services for individuals that needed it.
- 6) Enrollment in Driving classes for families of victims that needed to learn how to drive their family vehicle for access to transportation;
- 7) Access to food.
- 8) Gaming night & pizza with Tyler Heights teens.


Data from outreach and work in Madison Apartments and Tyler Heights Neighborhoods:


- 1) 90 Surveys to Spanish Speaking Latinos in our designated areas.
- 2) The large majority of our participants were women from 30-60 years of age.
- 3) 44.9% were originally from El Salvador, followed by 29.1% from Mexico
 - a) This is consistent with data provided by the City of Annapolis reports on Latino populations, in which the Salvadorian population is the largest subpopulations of latinos.
- 4) 89% of our respondents spoke Spanish fluently, and no English.
 - a) This is higher than the 82% mono-lingual spanish speaking population found by the City of Annapolis in 2021/2022
- 5) 92.1% Rent their homes, 7.9% own them
- 6) 87.6% have access to WiFi at home

74.2% respondents were women




¿Cuánto tiempo ha vivido en el Condado de Anne Arundel? 88 respuestas






27% unemployed: Factors influencing could be that we interviewed primarily women, spanish speakers, latinos.



Of those employed, 53% employed FT, and 42.4% Part time, in areas such as construction, babysitting, hotel workers, restaurants workers, landscaping, cleaning, and interpretation services

88.5% had high school diploma or less as their highest level of education completed.

31.7% have more than 6 people living in their homes.

52.7% have more than 2 adults living in their home.

Safety and comfort in neighborhoods.

<u>Satisfaction</u> with current living situation: 27% very satisfied. 34.8% not satisfied or very unsatisfied.

21.3% reported feeling safe in their neighborhoods. 29.2% do not feel safe in their neighborhoods.

Top concerns:

- 1) Vandalism
- 2) Violence
- 3) Tree canopy and park accessibility

78.7% Did not have health insurance.




- 1) 91% did not think access to medical services was easy to get when they needed it.
- 2) 92.9% are not satisfied with medical services available.
- 3) 20.2% have still not been vaccinated against COVID-19.
- 4) Largest barriers for access to healthcare:
 - a) Language
 - b) Discrimination
 - c) Cost
 - d) Length of waiting time
- 5) 50.6% did not know where to get health care services.

Still have work to do on information on access to services in these neighborhoods.
