Snow Emergency Routes

This legislation would establish that any person who fails to remove a vehicle from a snow emergency route when Phase II or Phase III of the snow emergency plan is in effect shall be in violation of the City Code and subject to the imposition of a fine.

Section 12.40.060 of the City Code currently provides the authority for the Police Department to remove parked vehicles from snow emergency routes in the state of an emergency, but it does not currently provide for a fine for initial and repeat violations. The companion resolution to this legislation is R-13-16, to which there is a Pantelides proposed amendment to amend the FY2017 Fines Schedule to add a \$250.00 fine for each initial and each repeat or continuous violation.
