16 **Delegation of Authority for Administrating Elections**

18 **FOR** the purpose of authorizing the City of Annapolis to contract with the Anne Arundel
19 County Board of Elections to administer the City of Annapolis Municipal Primary
20 and General Elections in 2025.

22 **WHEREAS,** The City Council is authorized by § 4.08.030 to contract with the Anne
23 Arundel County Board of Elections to administer any City election.

25 **WHEREAS,** Such delegation of administrative responsibility shall not derogate from
26 any ultimate decision-making authority granted under Title 4 to the Board
27 of Supervisors of Elections of the City.

29 **NOW, THEREFORE,**

30 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ANNAPOLIS CITY COUNCIL** that:

32 1. The City of Annapolis is authorized to:
- 33 a. Contract with the Anne Arundel County Board of Elections to administer
34 the City of Annapolis Primary on September 16, 2025, and Municipal
35 General Elections on November 4, 2025; and
 - 36 b. Provide for mail-in ballots as mutually agreed to by the City of Annapolis
37 Board of Supervisors of Elections and the Anne Arundel County Board of
38 Elections.
- 39 2. The City shall execute a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) between the City
40 of Annapolis and the Anne Arundel County Board of Elections regarding the
41 administration of the 2025 municipal elections.
