30 **SECTION I: BE IT ESTABLISHED AND ORDAINED BY THE ANNAPOLIS CITY**
31 **COUNCIL** that the Code of the City of Annapolis shall be amended to read as follows:

33 **Title 12 – VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC**

34 **Chapter 12.32 - SPECIAL RESIDENTIAL PARKING DISTRICTS**

36 **Section 12.32.120 - Permit—Display.**

38 The permit shall be VISIBLY DISPLAYED AND affixed to the vehicle as prescribed in the
39 regulations. The design and content of the permit shall be prescribed in the regulations. ~~Subject to~~
40 ~~the availability of funds, the Department of Transportation or the authorized agent may develop~~
41 ~~the capability of synchronizing the resident parking district permits with resident license plates so~~
42 ~~that no sticker, tag or barcode is required.~~
