

Resolution 7-17

EQUAL PROTECTION COMMISSION

The purpose of this Resolution is to create a Commission to study and provide the Mayor and City Council with a public forum to recommend and act to understand, mandate and enforce “equal protection under the law” in Annapolis.

The parameters proposed for establishing said Commission are as follows:

1. The members of the Commission shall be no more than 9, with a chair to be elected;
2. The members of the Commission shall serve without compensation;
3. The members of the Commission shall elect from among their membership a vice chair and secretary;
4. The Commission shall meet publicly at least once a month and, where feasible, shall take testimony from the public at each meeting;
5. Findings and recommendations shall be submitted publicly in a quarterly report to the Mayor and City Council; and
6. The business of the Commission shall be conducted consistent with the provisions of Robert’s Rules of Order (11th Edition).

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
