#### FY 2024 Fines Schedule Update - Abandoned Vehicle

**FOR** the purpose of increasing fines for abandoned vehicles in the City of Annapolis, and generally related to Title 12, Vehicles and Traffic.

WHEREAS, Abandoned vehicles are a nuisance and a blight on our community, which pose a safety hazard to pedestrians and motorists; and

WHEREAS, The current fines for abandoned vehicles are not sufficient to deter people from abandoning their vehicles

### NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ANNAPOLIS CITY COUNCIL that the Fees Schedule shall be amended as follows:

Section	Description	Fine for Initial Offense	Fine for Repeat or Continuous Violations
12.44.030.A	Wrecked or inoperable vehicles on public property	\$50.00 plus damages	\$100250.00 plus damages
12.44.040.B	Keeping wrecked or discarded vehicles	\$ <del>100</del> 250.00 per day	\$ <del>100</del> 250.00 per day

## AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED BY THE ANNAPOLIS CITY COUNCIL that the effective date of this resolution shall be its date of adoption.
