State aide for Police Protection (SAPP) is an annual program, managed by the Governor's Office of Crime Control & Prevention (GOCCP), to provide funds for police protection in qualifying jurisdictions. Funding is based on State- determined formulas which takes into account local population, sworn staffing levels, and legislative action.

In FY15, GOCCP is awarding \$768,849.00 to the City of Annapolis/ Annapolis Police Department, a qualifying jurisdiction. Funding will be used for officers' salaries.


(Strictly speaking, this is not a grant, but rather an annual allocation by the State, following leglislative actions, to qualifying jurisdictions. GOCCP uses their grant system as a convenience to record, track, and distribute funds.)

Award period is July 1, 2014 to June 30, 2015.

"Award" documents consist simply of a letter to the Chief of Police and the Finance Department. A copy is attached. Also attached is the list of officers whose salaries will be funded by this award.

Dear Chief Pristoop:

Please be advised that, pursuant to the FY 2015 State budget, Annapolis City Police Department will receive \$768,849.00 from the FY 2015 State Aid for Police Protection Fund. The State Aid for Police Protection Fund is an annual formula grant to be used exclusively to provide adequate police protection in the subdivisions and qualifying municipalities of Maryland.

Your estimated allocation for FY 2015 is derived by the information provided on forms #2 and #3. The actual amount of aid will be recalculated based on the actual FY 2014 expenditures for police protection that you will provide on form #1 which is due on January 15, 2015. Payments will be made on the last day of each quarter.

To participate in the FY 2016 State Aid for Police Protection program, an online application submission is required that is due on August 6, 2015. The application must also be mailed to GOCCP along with your completed Form #2 (Estimated Expenditures for FY 2015) and Form #3 (Number of Sworn Officers as of June 30, 2014). It is important that we receive all forms in a timely manner so that the formula may be calculated accurately.

The notice of funding availability, forms and instructions for FY2016 will be available on our website by no later than August 25, 2015 and can be downloaded through the online system at www.grants.goccp.maryland.gov.

Strictly speaking, this is not a competitive grant application but rather the forms required by the Governor's Office of Crime Control and Prevention (GOCCP) so they can distribute funds to multiple jurisdictions in Maryland for "adequate police protection." GOCCP distributes the funds based on a formula that involves population size and how much the Maryland Legislature appropriates for the program.

Funding amount will be decided by GOCCP; thus, "Amount Requested" remains blank. In past years, the amount made available to the City of Annapolis for the police department was about \$704,000; last year (for FY14), it was \$788,000.

No creative writing is required or allowed. GOCCP provides narrative, including "Article 41 of the Annotated Code of Maryland," which must be copied verbatim into the application. In previous years, the Finance Department submitted the paperwork to obtain these funds.

Period of award is July 1, 2014 - June 30, 2015.

Review and approval are requested through the chain of command, with signature by the Mayor -- in blue ink -- at the tabs on two documents: Form 2, Estimated Expenditures for Police Protection, and Form 3, Municipal Sworn Officer Allocation.

Due date for submission to GOCCP is August 12, 2013.
