AMENDMENT 2 – ALD. SAVIDGE

Amendment Summary:

Amendment 2 changes the City person who will be promulgating any parking time limit and fee changes in the Special Residental Parking Districts. It will be the Transportation Director in consultation with the City Manager. The director must inform the Council's Transportation Committee.

On page 3 in lines 20-23, page 6 in lines 27-29, page 11 in lines 1-3, page 14 in lines 15-17, page 16, in lines 21-23, strike everything after 'Hourly Parking." and insert "Parking hours shall be subject to regulations promulgated by the Department of Transportation director per § 12.24.070 in consultation with the City Manager. The director shall brief the City Council Transportation Committee of any changes."

As the change would look in the resolution:

B. Hourly parking. The City Manager shall promulgate parking hours and time limits in consultation with the director of the Department of Transportation per Section 12.24.070 of this title. The regulations shall be published on the City of Annapolis website. Parking hours shall be subject to regulations promulgated by the Department of Transportation director per § 12.24.070 in consultation with the City Manager. The director shall brief the City Council Transportation Committee of any changes.
