19 **Equal Protection Task Force – African-American Residents**

21 **FOR** the purpose of approving a one year extension of time for the temporary advisory
22 Task Force commissioned to provide the Mayor and City Council with a public
23 forum for studying and preparing reports about the issues of African-American
24 residents of the City of Annapolis to complete it mission.

25
26 **WHEREAS**, the City Council adopted R-24-18 on June 25, 2018, for the purpose of
27 establishing a temporary advisory Task Force to study and prepare reports
28 about the issues of African-American residents of the City of Annapolis;
29 and

31 **WHEREAS**, R-24-18 expires on June 30, 2019, and the temporary advisory Task Force
32 has yet to complete its study and reporting; and

33
34 **WHEREAS**, the City Council wishes to provide an additional year during which the
35 advisory Task Force may address concerns and questions raised about the
36 needs, circumstances, and issues of African-American residents in the City
37 of Annapolis in each of the following areas: 1) transportation, 2) education,
38 3) communication, 4) economics and finances, 5) social and political
39 concerns, 6) health care, 7) housing; and 8) city services and outreach.

41 **NOW, THEREFORE,**

43 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ANNAPOLIS CITY COUNCIL** that a one year extension
44 of time is approved for the advisory task force to address concerns and questions raised
45 about the needs, circumstances, and issues of African-American residents in the City of
46 Annapolis in each of the following areas: 1) transportation, 2) education, 3)

1 communication, 4) economics and finances, 5) social and political concerns, 6) health care,
2 7) housing, and 8) city services and outreach, and that the term of the Task Force shall end
3 June 30, 2020, unless the City Council takes further action to extend such term.

5 **AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED BY THE ANNAPOLIS CITY COUNCIL** that
6 this resolution shall take effect from the date of its passage.
