23 **FOR** the purpose of adding Class E to those classes of license holders currently
24 authorized to sell draft beer in refillable containers.

26 **BY** repealing and re-enacting with amendments the following portions of the Code of
27 the City of Annapolis, 2015 Edition
28 7.12.335

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31 **SECTION I: BE IT ESTABLISHED AND ORDAINED BY THE ANNAPOLIS**
32 **CITY COUNCIL** that the Code of the City of Annapolis shall be amended to read as
33 follows:

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35 **Chapter 7.12 ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES**

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37 **7.12.335 - Additional license class—Refillable container license.**

39 A. The Alcoholic Beverage Control Board may issue to Class A, Class B, ~~and~~ Class
40 D, AND CLASS E license holders a class of license that authorizes refillable
41 containers. The suffix ".g" shall indicate that a license permits the sale of draft
42 beer in refillable containers.
43 B. Subject to paragraph C. of this section, the classes of license authorizing the sale
44 of draft beer in refillable containers entitle the license holder to sell, for
45 consumption off the licensed premises, draft beer in refillable containers with a

- 1 capacity of not less than thirty-two ounces and not more than one hundred twenty-
2 eight ounces.
- 3 C. To be used as a refillable container under Paragraph B. of this section, a container
4 shall:
- 5 1. Be sealable;
6 2. Be branded with an identifying mark of a license holder;
7 3. Bear the Federal Health Warning Statement required for containers of alcoholic
8 beverages under 27 C.F.R. 16.21;
9 4. Display instructions for cleaning the container; and
10 5. Bear a label stating that:
11 a. Cleaning the container is the responsibility of the consumer; and
12 b. The contents of the container are perishable, should be refrigerated immediately,
13 and should be consumed within forty-eight hours after purchase.
- 14 D. The term of a refillable container license issued to a successful applicant shall be
15 the same as the term of the license that the applicant holds at the time of
16 application.
- 17 E. The hours of sale for a refillable container license shall begin at the same time as
18 the hours for the license already held by the license holder and shall end at
19 midnight.
- 20 F. A license holder may refill only a refillable container that was branded by a
21 license holder.
- 22 G. The Alcoholic Beverage Control Board shall adopt regulations to carry out this
23 section.
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26 **SECTION II: AND BE IT FURTHER ESTABLISHED AND ORDAINED BY**
27 **THE ANNAPOLIS CITY COUNCIL** that this ordinance shall take effect from the date
28 of its passage.
