AN ORDINANCE concerning

Title 17 Updates and Amendments

FOR the purpose of updating and amending Chapters 17.04 and 17.08 of the Annapolis City Code to permit an authorized agent of the City to prohibit the use and sale of coal tar pavement products; and matters generally relating to prohibiting the use and sale of coal tar pavement products.

BY repealing and re-enacting with amendments the following portions of the Code of the City of Annapolis, 2015 Edition
17.04.655
17.04.955
17.08.180

SECTION I: BE IT ESTABLISHED AND ORDAINED BY THE ANNAPOLIS CITY COUNCIL that the Code of the City of Annapolis shall be amended to read as follows:

TITLE 17 – BUILDINGS AND CONSTRUCTION

CHAPTER 17.04 - DEFINITIONS

17.04.655 – Pollutant.

1 "Pollutant" means any liquid, gaseous, solid, or other substances, INCLUDING COAL
2 TAR PAVEMENT PRODUCTS AS DEFINED IN SECTION 17.08.180, which will
3 cause water pollution of a water resource of the City.

4
5 **17.04.955 – Water pollution.**

6
7 "Water pollution" means any contamination, INCLUDING COAL TAR PAVEMENT
8 PRODUCTS AS DEFINED IN SECTION 17.08.180, or other alteration of the physical,
9 chemical, or biological properties of any waters, including a change in temperature, taste,
10 color, turbidity, or odor of the waters or the discharge or deposit of any organic matter,
11 harmful organism, or liquid, gaseous, solid, radioactive, or other substance into any
12 waters that will render the waters harmful, or detrimental to public health and safety,
13 legitimate beneficial uses, wild animals, or aquatic life.

15 **CHAPTER 17.08 – GRADING, EROSION AND SEDIMENT CONTROL**

16
17 **17.08.180 – Prohibited discharges AND PROHIBITED USE OF COAL TAR**
18 **PAVEMENT PRODUCTS.**

19
20 A. No debris, sediment, wastewater, landscaping/yard waste, refuse, or other
21 pollutant shall be deposited in floodplains, water resources, public streets, highways,
22 sidewalks, storm drains, or other public thoroughfares per this chapter of the City Code,
23 Maryland Environment Title 4 as may be amended from time to time, COMAR 26.08.04,
24 unless otherwise permitted by the City of Annapolis or the Maryland Department of the
25 Environment. Such materials shall be stored properly to minimize any threat of discharge.

26
27 B. THIS SECTION APPLIES TO ALL PUBLIC AND PRIVATE USES OF COAL
28 TAR PAVEMENT PRODUCTS, AS DEFINED BELOW:

- 30 1. "COAL TAR PAVEMENT PRODUCT" MEANS A MATERIAL THAT
31 CONTAINS COAL TAR OR POLYCYCLIC AROMATIC HYDROCARBONS
32 AND IS USED FOR AN ASPHALT OR CONCRETE SURFACE.
 - 33
34 2. A PERSON MAY NOT SELL, OFFER FOR SALE, USE, OR PERMIT THE
35 USE OF A COAL TAR PAVEMENT PRODUCT IN THE CITY. A PROPERTY
36 OWNER WHO KNOWINGLY PERMITS THE APPLICATION OF A
37 PRODUCT CONTAINING COAL TAR PAVEMENT PRODUCT ON THEIR
38 PROPERTY SHALL BE IN VIOLATION OF THIS SECTION AND MAY BE
39 CITED, IN ADDITION TO THE APPLICATOR OF THE PRODUCT,
40 PURSUANT TO SUBSECTION (B)(4).
 - 41
42 3. THE DIRECTOR SHALL PUBLISH A LIST OF ALTERNATIVE PRODUCTS
43 FOR USE ON ASPHALT AND CONCRETE THAT DO NOT CONTAIN A
44 COAL TAR PAVEMENT PRODUCT.

1 4. VIOLATORS OF THIS SECTION SHALL BE REQUIRED TO REMEDIATE
 2 THE SURFACE OF THE COAL TAR PAVEMENT PRODUCT. A
 3 VIOLATION OF THIS SECTION SHALL BE A MUNICIPAL INFRACTION
 4 AND SUBJECT TO A FINE AS ESTABLISHED BY RESOLUTION OF THE
 5 CITY COUNCIL. EACH DAY THAT A VIOLATION OCCURS SHALL BE
 6 CONSIDERED A SEPARATE OFFENSE. THE PENALTIES SET FORTH IN
 7 THIS SECTION ARE IN ADDITION TO ANY OTHER REMEDIES AND
 8 PENALTIES PROVIDED UNDER FEDERAL, STATE, COUNTY, OR LOCAL
 9 LAW.

10
 11 **SECTION II: AND BE IT FURTHER ESTABLISHED AND ORDAINED BY**
 12 **THE ANNAPOLIS CITY COUNCIL** that this ordinance shall take effect from the date
 13 of its passage.
