A.	A mooring permit issued by the Harbormaster is valid for work commenced within a period
	of sixty days from the issuance of the permit; otherwise, it is void. Work permitted by a
	mooring permit shall be completed within three months of the date of issuance of the permit,
	unless an extension is granted by the Port Wardens for good cause.
	Moorings not in continuous use for more than sixty consecutive days during the period of May
	1st to October 31st shall be automatically forfeited to the City. A MOORING SHALL NOT
	BE IN DISUSE FOR MORE THAN 30 CONSECUTIVE DAYS FROM JUNE 1 <sup>ST</sup>
	THROUGH OCTOBER 1 <sup>ST</sup> . IN ADDITION, A MOORING SHALL BE OCCUPIED BY
