


Maryland Police Reform Act Implementation

Accountability Board, Charging Committee and Trial Board Process

Annapolis PD Has been working with A.A. County Government to create an Accountability Board, Charging Committee and Trial Boards that will serve all AA County law enforcement agencies

In Compliance with HB 670, APD will create a front-facing portal for the public where the public can make complaints online, and follow complaints made after July 1, 2022 through the online system

Changing Body-worn camera buffering from 30 seconds to sixty seconds on March 1, four months before the provision is to take effect in law
