mental health is part of everone's overall health and well being, and mental illness is prevalent in our City, state and

	nation, with one in five adults experiencing a mental health issue every year; and
WHEREAS	the COVID-19 pandemic has increased the number of people experiencing feelings of anxiety and depression; and
WHEREAS	stigma and the resulting discrimination is a primary obstacle to early identification and effective treatment of individuals with mental illness and their ability to recover to lead full, productive lives; and
WHEREAS	approximately half of chronic mental illness begins by the age of 14 and suicides is the second leading cause of death of people ages 10 to 24; and
WHEREAS	suicide is the 10 th leading cause of death in the United States and the 2 nd leading cause among young adults; 90 percent of people who die by suicide had shown symptoms of a mental health conditions, according to interviews with family, friends, and medical professionals; In Maryland in 2021, 650 lives were lost to suicide; and
WHEREAS	Marylanders are ten times more likely to be forced out-of-network for mental health care than for primary health care – making it more difficult to find care and less affordable due to higher out-of-pocket costs; and
WHEREAS	more than 780,000 adults in Maryland are living with a mental health condition. That is 19 times the population of the City of Annapolis; and
WHEREAS	we come together with every citizen and community to help end the silence and stigma that for too long has made people feel isolated, alone and sicouraged people from getting help; and
WHEREAS	through public education and working together to raise awareness, we can help improve the lives of individuals and families affected by mental illness.
