RE: PFAS Concerns Firefighting Foam and Turnout Gear

Firefighting Foam

- Currently using Universal Gold (AFFF)
 - Contains PFAS
 - Only able to utilize under emergency conditions
 - Current Inventory
 - 39 (5 gallon) Pails in storage and on apparatus (195 Gallons Total)
 - 35 gallons in holding tank on FB36
 - 30 gallons in holding tank on E371
 - New Option is Universal Green
 - o Fluorine Free
 - o No intentionally added PFAS
 - Universal^{®F3} Green has achieved GreenScreen certification. GreenScreen Certified[™] is an independent, non-profit certification that promotes the use of inherently safer chemicals in products and manufacturing
 - Will require training
 - Different concentration
 - Slightly different tactics needed
 - o Cost to replace current stock and allow amount for training
 - \$12,831.60
- Disposal

- Private Company
 - Disposal of entire stock and on-board holding tanks pump out
 - \$3,997.98 (Not including disposal of FB36 actual holding tank)
- Purchase of new holding tank for FB36
 - Awaiting Pricing (Based on quick search could be \$500 to \$700)

Turnout Gear

- Past two years we have been working on transitioning into a new turnout gear manufacturer from Globe to FireDex. Both Manufacturers have outer shells and thermal barriers that are PFAS Free
 - Globe Turnout Gear contains Crosstech Black, 2F Moisture Barrier (86 members using)
 - Laminated to the fabric that could have PFAS more exposed
 - FireDex Turnout Gear contains Stedair 4000 (49 members using)
 - Bi-component membrane that seals PFAS material between the membrane
- There is currently no manufacturer that makes a moisture barrier that is PFAS free
- Stedair 4000 is the best current option
 - To transition 86 members out of current Globe gear into FireDex \$272,362.00
 - To add a second set of gear for everyone providing a backup set during gear cleaning after fire incidents \$452,881.00
 - Currently and if we do not provide second set of gear we would only have Globe turnouts that can be loaned out during gear cleaning and/or repair
 - Total for both \$725,243
