# § <u>10-1104</u>. <u>Club public event permit</u> — Sales authorized.

- (a) There is a <u>club public event permit</u>.
- (b) The Board may issue the *permit* to a holder of a Class C license.
- (c) Subject to subsection (d) of this section, the <u>permit</u> authorizes a <u>club</u> to sell alcoholic beverages that are allowed under the <u>club</u>'s Class C license:
  - (1) during a *public event* sponsored by the *club* at the place described in the license;
  - (2) to an individual who is not a member of the <u>club</u> or a guest of a member; and
  - (3) for on-premises consumption.

(d)

- (1) A permit holder shall:
  - (i) submit an application for approval to the Board at least 45 days before a public event; and
  - (ii) obtain the approval of the Board before each public event.
- (2) The Board, in its discretion, may approve up to 12 <u>public events</u> per <u>permit</u> holder in a calendar year.
