20 **FOR** the purpose of supporting the distribution of grant funds through the Maryland Department
21 of Housing and Community Development (DHCD) Neighborhood BusinessWorks
22 Program (NBW Program) to Lillys Printing LLC, which was severely impacted by the
23 Hurricane Ida disaster.

26 **WHEREAS**, on September 1, 2021, spurred by Hurricane Ida, an EF-2 Tornado ripped through
27 Annapolis with peak wind speeds reaching approximately 125 mph. In the
28 aftermath, several small businesses were forced to shutter; and

30 **WHEREAS**, The Maryland DHCD has received funding for this current fiscal year through the
31 NBW Program to support Maryland small businesses affected by the Hurricane Ida
32 disaster; and

34 **WHEREAS**, Lillys Printing LLC has applied to the NBW Program for financing to purchase
35 new equipment and furniture, and to replace working capital due to lost revenue
36 during the business closure at 1801 West Street, Suite 100, Annapolis, MD 21401;

39 **WHEREAS**, in order for grant funds to be released to Lillys Printing LLC, the City of Annapolis
40 is required to show its support for the project by passing a resolution endorsing the
41 financing; and

43 **WHEREAS**, the City of Annapolis is interested in promoting the revitalization of our community
44 by encouraging the development and expansion of for-profit and non-profit small
45 businesses.

3 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ANNAPOLIS CITY COUNCIL** that the City of Annapolis
4 endorses the distribution of grant funds to Lillys Printing LLC.
