

## STAFF REPORT ON PROPOSED LEGISLATION

Subject: O-37-22, Art in Public Places – Arts fund appropriations by Council

This Ordinance <u>removes</u> the following section of the City Code addressing the appropriation of funds to the Art in Public Places Commission (AIPPC):

"Subject to the appropriation of funds by the City Council, said fund may be credited with one-tenth of one percent of the general fund revenues and all funds received by the City for the arts, including visual art in public places, the performing arts and works of art, whether contributed, earned, secured through grants or otherwise obtained."

As the AIPPC receives a specified portion of the City's hotel tax each year, additional appropriation of funds from the City Council is thought to no longer be required.
