Subject: R-XX-22: City Supported Special Events in Fiscal Year 2023

The following events are designated as City-Supported Events pursuant to Section 14.18.020:

- St. Patrick's Day Parade
- Martin Luther King, Jr. Parade and Diaspora Concert and Festival
- Memorial Day Parade
- Juneteenth Parade and Festival
- Independence Day Parade
- Elk's Pre-Labor Day Parade
- Kunta Kinte Festival
- Tug of War
- Veterans Day Ceremony
- Grand Illumination
- Lights Parade
- New Year's Eve Celebration

Under Section 14.18.020, a "City-<u>Supported</u> Event" is a special event for which the City waives some or all of the fees pursuant to Section 14.18.110 of the City Code, or for which the City agrees to provide financial or in-kind support and be identified as a sponsor. The City shall not be the applicant or an event organizer for a City-supported event.

This resolution also waives certain fees for certain City-<u>Supported</u> Events pursuant to Sections 14.18.110 and 6.04.210 of the City Code. The actual amount of fees that will be waived will be determined after each event has occurred in fiscal year 2023.

There are no fees assessed or waived for the Memorial Day Parade, Independence Day Parade, or New Year's Eve Celebration, all of which are events organized by the City.
